The epigraph from Virginia Woolf's novel *To The Lighthouse* sets the tone for Todd Crawshaw's strange, daring, and beautiful collection of StoryPoems, *Light-Years in the Dark*. Meant for those who seek inspiration and the meaning of life, the book takes readers on a vital metaphysical and spiritual journey through both darkness and light. A StoryPoem, defined by the author, is a hybrid genre of poetry and short story inspired by Cranes *The Black Riders* and *Other Lines* and Debussy's *Preludes for Piano*, where each concise piece is a cosmos, a distilled symphony. In *Light-Years in the Dark*, Crawshaw has invented a magical world that is elaborately imaginative, often haunting, and bursting with stunning imagery. An alternate universe alternating between lightness and darkness, a yin-yang composition of interacting forces, this collection is analogous to a rich assortment of light and dark chocolates contained in a box: each is meant to be savored slowly, carefully ingested, in a quiet space that allows for contemplation and reflection. Some short, others long, these are tales about a variety of characters, ideas, and emotions: a two-headed man, a woman of incomplete mind,...
