S. producers could be competitive even in our weakest industries or, at a different configuration of exchange rates, not competitive even in our strongest. Second, the most fundamental economic concept of international trade - Ricardos principle of comparative advantage - dictates that a country will export the goods and services in which it is relatively competitive, and import the goods and services in which it is not - even if it is extremely efficient at producing goods and services in the latter category. By definition, a country cannot have a comparative advantage in producing everything, and thus it cannot have a uniform cost advantage. Thus, a comparison of domestic and foreign costs, though perhaps intuitively appealing, is not a useful measure of competitiveness. A better approach to measuring competitiveness relies on a comparison of produc-tivity, the amount of goods...
